## THEA

#### Archeology meets modern.

The designer Designer Daniel Eltner dedicated this series to the invention of the potter's wheel during the bronze age ( ca. 2000 v.Chr.) in europe and asia minor. Now it was possible to create rotationally symmetric vessels for storage and consumption of food and beverages. Archetypical vessels resulted, chracterized by functionality, trading and culture. The form of THEA teapot is a symbol of a serving and conserving vessel. A very large pot of tea which gives space to the tea to unfold its flavour. From the lateral view the teapot has a V- formation which canalizes the tea directly into the spout and guarantees a very comfortable Handling.


Italo- american coffee culture in europe.




Bauhaus goes Italy

Porcelain series Foro, projected by the German designer Daniel Eltner, combines shape and functionality in a very strict aesthetic form. The shape of each individual container, from horizontal to vertical, has been developed to meet the aromatic requirements of particular meals and drinks.

The cups and bowls are stackable with one another and create a space-saving micro-architectural setting at the table.


Vento (italian for "wind") denotes the poetry of the wind. The wind knows no bounds, wind units cultures and is a symbol of change, like the form changes from convex to concave. 



#### 500 years of vision & design

The portuguese discovered india in 1498 by the visionary way to circumnavigate west africa. On may 20th of 1515 Afonso de Albuquerque brought an indian rhinoceros to Lisbon and forwarded it to his king Manuel I. of Portugal. A sensation, to date nobody had seen before an indian rhinoceros alive before.

In the very same year Albrecht Dürer created in Nuremberg 1515 his famous woodcut of the indian rhinoceros which he has never seen personally in his life, only by sketches and descriptions of an unknown artist.


The german industrial designer Daniel Eltner had a fictional dialogue together with Albrecht Dürer and created a sculpture which interpretes Dürers 500 years old vision of an indian rhinoceros in a contemporary way.

The so created Metapheros is conceived as a symbol for visionary design the world has never seen before.

And a general metaphoric statement for visions in art & design, which become reality à la Kurt Weidemann "Only that person is realistic who believes in visions. "

Albrecht Dürer was the godfather for the collaboration between the german designer Daniel Eltner and Alessandro Mendini.

The rider by Dürer from Mendini (2011) and the rhinoceros by Dürer from Eltner (2015) are reflecting the common passion for the Renaissance painter and the dialogue between the two.

Daniel asked Alessandro for an decorative interpretation of his rhinoceros.

This is how their collaboration begins. The project ideas often come from the history of art.

An enigmatic contemporary triptych.






#### The devil is in the details
